**Credit by Demonstrated Mastery** - Credit by Demonstrated Mastery (CDM) is an option for obtaining high school course credit for standard level courses (honors level and AP level courses are excluded) in North Carolina. CDM is the process by which a local school system shall, based upon a body-of-evidence, award a student credit in a particular high school course without requiring the student to complete classroom instruction. To earn credit for a high school course and by-pass the seat time requirements, students shall demonstrate mastery for the course through a two-phase process: Phase 1: A standard examination; Phase 2: An artifact - A project that demonstrates the student's deep understanding of the content standards. The deadline for accepting applications is February 10<sup>th</sup>. Phase one assessment will occur during the timeframe of February 15 – 28.
