Free Sports Physicals - Perquimans County Schools is proud to announce Free Sports Physical Day, sponsored by Sentara for all student athletes in Perquimans County Schools. The event is scheduled for May 23, 2017 and will be held in the gymnasium at Perquimans County High School. In order for a student athlete to qualify for the free physical, he/she must have all athletic forms completed and signed by the parent/guardian prior to the event. The student must bring the forms to the coaches at PCHS for approval. Once accepted, the student will be eligible to participate. Student athletes with completed documents will receive the free physical from doctors, nurses and athletic trainers from Sentara as well as Perquimans County Schools nurses

beginning at 4:45 pm. There will be an interest meeting for potential student athletes to receive paperwork and review physical guidelines on Monday during PQ Time.
