- 1) Junior Women's Club of Perquimans County's Sallie Southall Cotton Scholarship \$1,000 – a) be in top 25% of your class; b) plan to attend 4-year college or university in North Carolina; c) be a NC resident. **DUE NOVEMBER 30, 2017**
- 2) PAL Scholarship – Students to present their best work for a monetary scholarship of \$500. Categories include Fine Arts or Crafts, Music, Dance or Drama, Theater Arts or Creative Writing. **DUE JANUARY 10, 2018**
- 3) Rotary's Jack Kanoy Scholarship – Students who plan to attend at 2-year or 4-year college or university. **DUE MARCH 17, 2018**
- 4) Parksville Ruritan Club \$500 – a) be a PCHS senior; b) be in top 1/3 of class; and c) demonstrate financial need. **DUE MARCH 1, 2018**
- 5) Perquimans County Schools Foundation (20 different scholarships) - ONE APPLICATION to be included in all - **DUE JANUARY 4, 2018**
